American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act of 2021 Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER)

SUMMARY:

On March 11, 2021, the President signed into law the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP). ARP makes available \$122.8 billion nationally in a third round of Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) funds. New York State has been allocated nearly \$9 billion under the ARP Act's Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) Fund. The ARP Act requires that a minimum of \$8.09 billion (90 percent) be allocated to Local Educational Agencies (LEAs), including charter schools and Special Act School Districts that are LEAs. At least 20% of an LEA's allocation must be reserved to address the academic impact of lost instructional time.

Anticipated Total ARP Funding Allocation for BCSD: \$3,963,324

Reserved 20% of funds to address academic impact: \$792,665

Remaining 80% of funds for other activities to address needs arising from the coronavirus pandemic:

\$3,170,659

ARP Funding Activities for Bedford Central School District:

 Replacement of chromebooks, additional hardware, and soundfield systems, which provide classroom amplification to overcome limitations of masks and barriers

Staffing to lower class size and address academic impact of lost instructional time:
