

The Community

The **Bedford Central School District** is located approximately 45 miles north of NYC in suburban Northern Westchester County, NY. The school district is composed of one high school, one middle school and five elementary schools and has a richly diverse (socioeconomically, culturally & ethnically) population, serving students from the towns of Mount Kisco, Pound Ridge, and the hamlets of Bedford Hills, Bedford Village and Bedford Corners. Our district spans 59 square miles and has a population of 32,000 residents. The district has 17% English Language Learners, & 35% of our students access Free & Reduced Lunch. Fox Lane HS is a comprehensive four-year public high school with an approximate enrollment of 1200 students and a current senior class of 275.

Academics

Class Rank/Weighting Policy: Fox Lane HS does not rank students. As of the class of 2020, FLHS transcripts show both the weighted and unweighted GPA. Most courses with an H (Honors) or AP (Advanced Placement) designation will receive 10 add-on points in calculating the weighted cumulative average (GPA). The 10 points are not added to the final course average shown on the transcript but is used in GPA calculation only.

Grading: Numeric grades are awarded on a 0-100 point scale with 65% as passing. The GPAs listed on the transcript were calculated at the end of 11th grade. When a **letter** grade is posted the key is as follows: AUD – Audit Class, DRP – Dropped Class, E – Excessive Absences, I – Incomplete, NG – No Grade, NI – Needs Improvement, P – Passing, PH – Passing w/Honors.

Transfer Students: Transfer students receive a grade of "P" (Pass) for credits earned at other schools and are <u>not</u> calculated into the Fox Lane High School GPA.

Graduation Requirements (22 *credits*): English, 4; Social Studies, 4; Math, 3; Science, 3; World Language, 1; Physical Education, 2; Aesthetic, 1; Health, .5; Electives, 3.5

COVID-19 Statement: FLHS was fully remote from March-June 2020. For 2020-21 students chose either a hybrid or fully remote from September-March, from April-June students chose either fully in-school or fully remote. FLHS was fully in-person for 2021-22. The NY SED waived all NYS Regents exams for students who passed the associated course for 2020 & 2021. All students received an E (EXEMPT) for those exams. <u>No</u> Regents exams are included on transcripts.

Note: Some grade level exceptions are made on a case-by-case basis with departmental approval.



Students can formally override a teacher's recommendation with parental permission. The only courses tracked from middle school are Math and World Language.

Class of 2024 Grade Distribution Chart




