o A grade of PD will be earned if the teacher determines that the student has exceeded the expectations of essential learning for the course.

o A grade of P will be earned if the teacher determines that the student has satisfactorily evidenced the essential learning for the course.

o A grade of NI will be earned if the teacher determines that the student has not evidenced the essential learning for the course.

• **Final Grades for Algebra and Accelerated World Language** follow the high school and will be calculated based on the following weighting:

o Quarter 1 – 35%

o Quarter 2 – 35%

o Quarter 3 – 30% (Grading floor 60%)

o Quarter 4 – Final averages may be raised for work completed during the 4th quarter.
