Dear Parents and Guardians,

Should you have questions about your child's grades, contact your child's teacher. Please note that it may take a few days to respond to your inquiry. If you receive no response, contact your child's assistant principal.

- Grades for this marking period will be notated in the gradebook using the terms **Passing with Distinction (PD), Passing (P), or Needs Improvement (NI)**. Attached is a rubric, further explaining the terms of grading.

- o A grade of PD will be earned if the teacher determines that the student has exceeded the expectations of essential learning for the course.

- o A grade of P will be earned if the teacher determines that the student has satisfactorily evidenced the essential learning for the course.

- o A grade of NI will be earned if the teacher determines that the student has not evidenced the essential learning for the course.

- **Final Grades for Algebra and Accelerated World Language** follow the high school and will be calculated based on the following weighting:

- o Quarter 1 – 35%

- o Quarter 2 – 35%

- o Quarter 3 – 30% (Grading floor 60%)

- o Quarter 4 – Final averages may be raised for work completed during the 4th quarter.
